



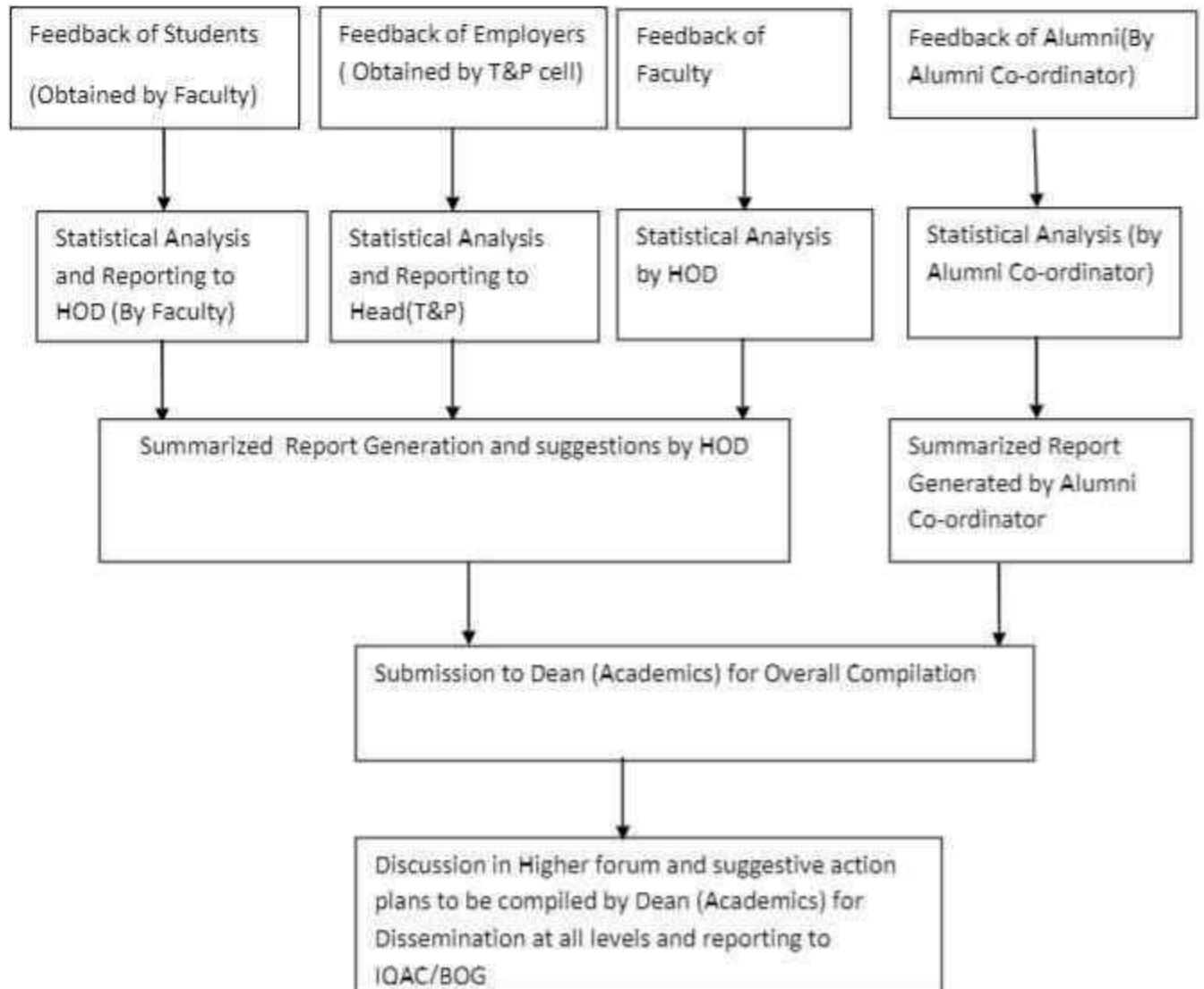

**Summary of the curriculum related feedback received from various stakeholders has been analyzed. The following recommendations/suggestions in light of the feedback are given as:**

**Academic year: 2023-24**

**Date: 21-05-2024**

Based on the curriculum related feedback, received from various stake holders, the departments have identified the need to organize special workshops/seminars/expert talks to supplement the curriculum and have made some recommendations in this regard which are listed below:

- a. The Applied Sciences Department has proposed to organize literary events and cultural activities. To motivate the students, competitions, expert lectures, workshops and seminars may also be arranged.
- b. Based on the feedback analysis, the Computer Science and Engineering Department proactively suggest to organize workshops and seminars that demonstrate the practical application of modern software development tools and technologies used in the industry. Establish support systems for student-led entrepreneurial ventures, including mentorship programs and access to resources has been planned.
- c. The Civil Engineering Department has proposed to organize expert talks with alumni and other distinguished personalities in the field of Civil Engineering to motivate the students. In addition, field visits at various engineering sites, including dams and railway tracks, may be arranged. A webinar on STAAD software can also be planned to improve students' software abilities.
- d. The Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering has proposed to organize expert talks and quizzes on emerging technologies to provide insights into the latest trends and advancements. In addition, poster-making and PPT presentation competitions may be planned to improve the technical and soft skills of the students. Industrial visits may also be arranged to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and professional application.
- e. The Electrical Engineering Department has proposed to organize Industrial expert talks on recent trends in Electrical Systems and also Educational visits (Industry/Institution) to improve students' practical skills. This will bridge the gap between academia and industry and also benefit the department's academic and professional growth.
- f. The Department of Mechanical Engineering suggested that to enhance the knowledge of students, a motivational session by a successful entrepreneur and a paper-making competition on ISHRAE Student Day may be arranged. Also, technical talks on important topics of mechanical engineering may be arranged by the department.
- g. The Department of Management Studies has suggested industry expert talk and alumni lectures along with that aptitude quiz and additional courses may also be included to enhance skills of the students.
- h. The Agriculture Engineering Department has suggested to visit various industries and other higher educational institutions to explore the new innovations in agriculture sector. The

department has planned some seminars, workshops and expert talks in various fields under agriculture engineering, so that the knowledge of students can be enhanced.

- i. In the alumni feedback analysis, it was observed that the emphasis should be put on enhancing the soft skills and technical skills of the students. In order to meet the above purpose, the alumni cell and the respective department heads have suggested arranging lectures on communication skills and personality development for the students. Technical events at the department level will also be organized.
- j. In the employer feedback analysis, it has been noted that consistent efforts should be made on students' professional grooming, communication skills and institute-industry partnerships. The Training & Placement cell has suggested the implementation of interdisciplinary subjects and the prioritization of the role of AI/ML and newer manufacturing techniques in academia.

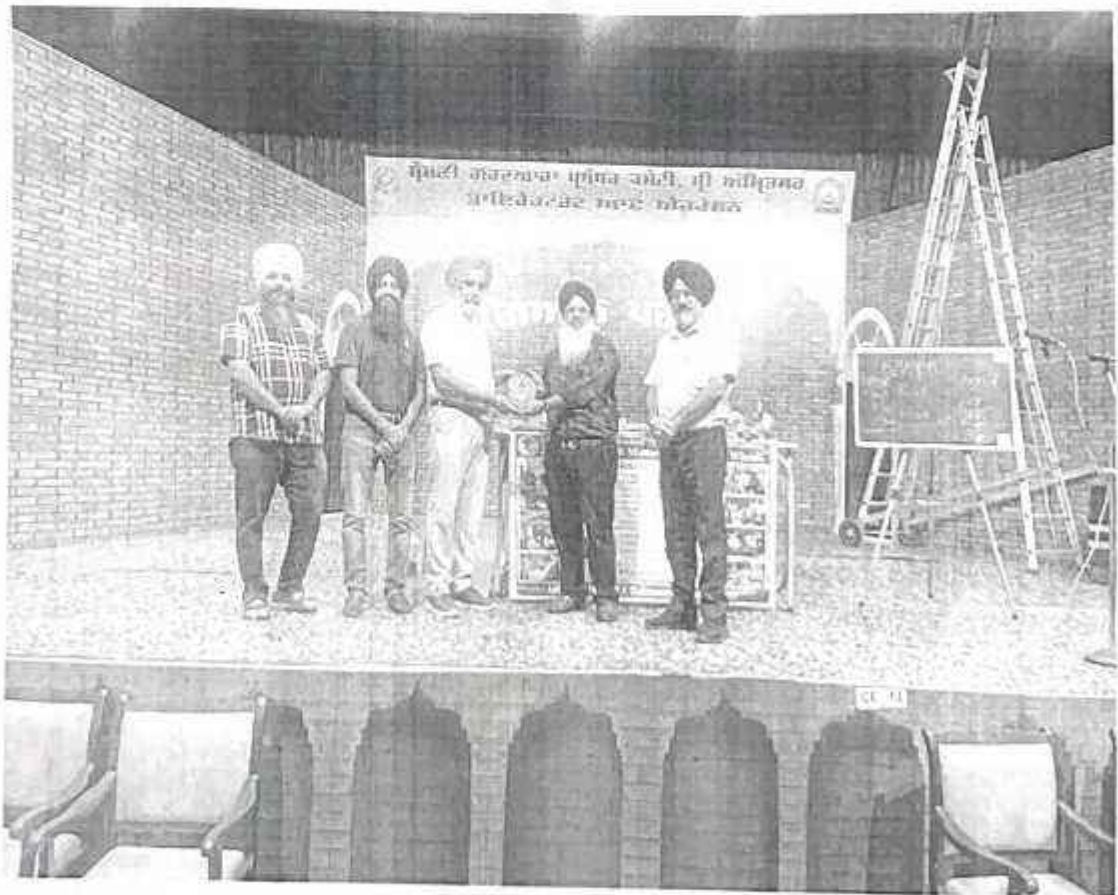



- **Networking Opportunities:** Students had the chance to connect with industry professionals, which may prove beneficial for future internships and job placements.

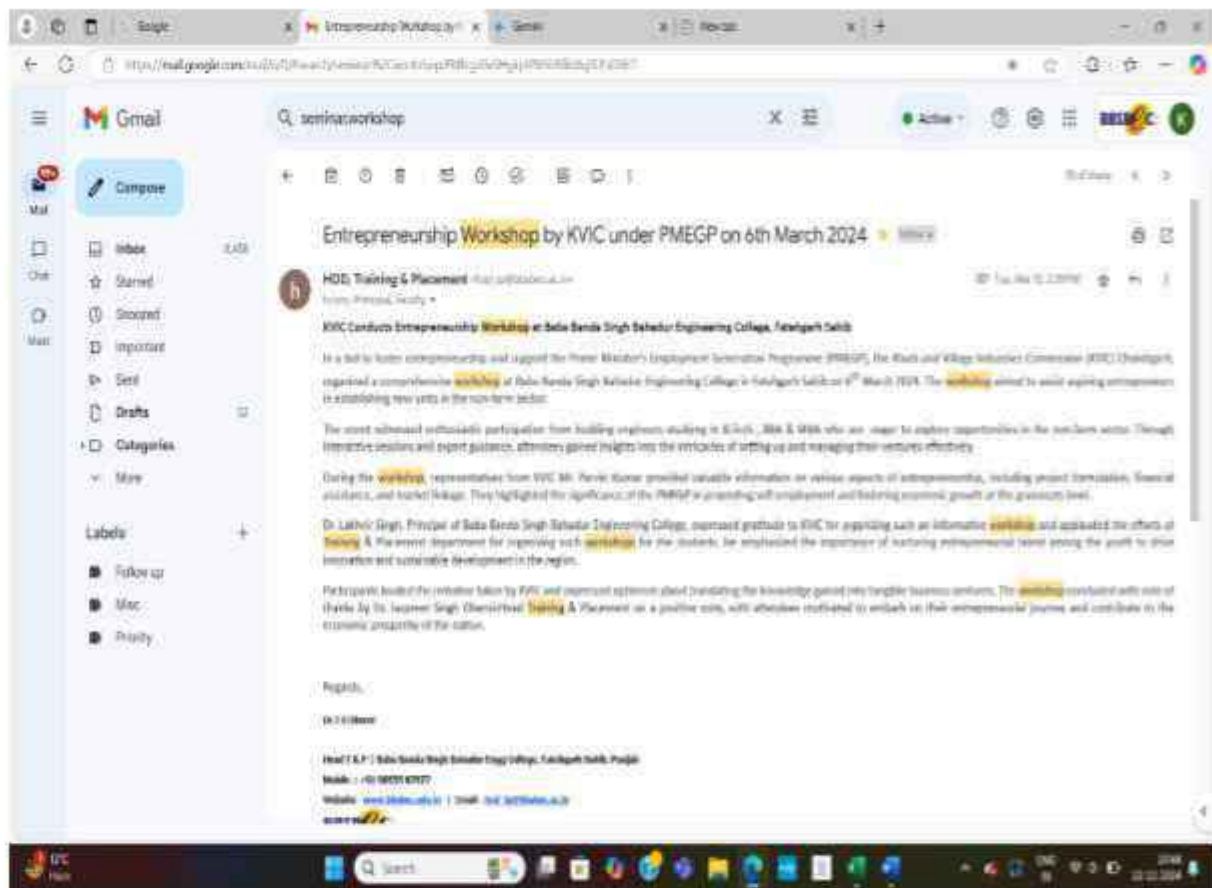

*(Seminar on "Problem Solving and Idea Generation" conducted on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2023)*

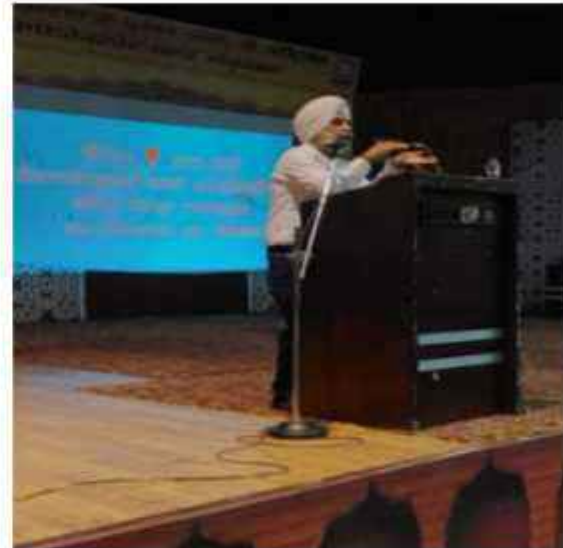

The Electronics & Communication Engineering Department of Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Engineering College, Fatehgarh Sahib arranged a Short term Course on "Employability Skills for Industry 4.0" scheduled from 16 – 20 October, 2023 organized By Entrepreneurship Development And Industrial Coordination (EDIC) Department, NITTTR, Chandigarh. The course is conducted in online mode as Remote Center of NITTTR, Chandigarh. 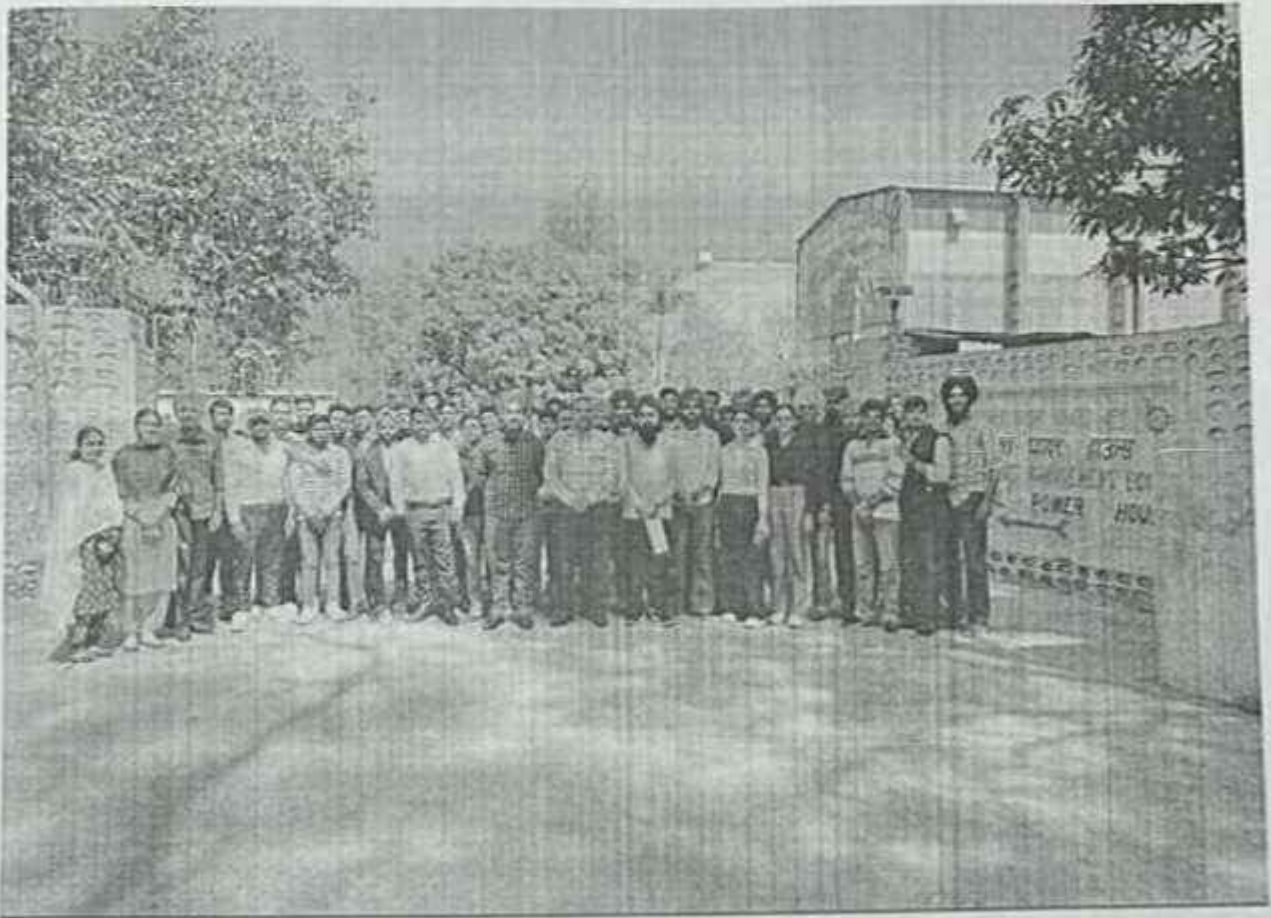


