9. AREAS OF MUTUAL INTEREST



5. The SKP will conduct appropriate training sessions for the vocational/skill portion of the vocational education programs so as to complete the vocational/skill portion within the given period/semester.

7. SKP will provide Technical Content in the form of theoretical calculations along with figures for STAAD PRO/ E-Tabs/ SOLID WORKS/RIVET has to be endorsed prior to start of training.
8. SKP will provide Single Copy of the Manual of the training (MENTIONED in point 7) in the form of Hard Copy and SOFT COPY has to be submitted to HOD for checking of contents prior to start of training.
9. The SKP will also arrange a visit to the project site during the period of the training, but the cost of transportation will be borne by the institute.
10. SKP will provide 100% placement assistance and guarantee to appear in the interview in reputed companies for minimum **ten** students.

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
